Since then, The Bendigo Trust has continued to run the Central Deborah Gold Mine, while overseeing some of Bendigo's other cherished historic assets, including reviving the Bendigo Tramways, the Discovery Science & Technology Centre, the Bendigo Gasworks and Victoria Hill, site of some of the earliest gold workings in Bendigo from the 1850's.

The newest addition to the Bendigo Trust is the Bendigo Chinese Joss House at Emu Point, one of the few remaining authentic buildings of this type left in Victoria.

OUR ATTRACTIONS

The surface of the **Central Deborah Gold Mine** was opened to tourists in 1970 and, following extensive works, underground areas of the mine were opened to tourists 16 years later in 1986. Today, the Central Deborah Gold Mine is Australia's premier underground tourist mine experience.

The **Bendigo Vintage 'Talking' Tram** service commenced in December 1972 and remains in operation today—with tours run every day except Christmas Day.

The **Discovery Science & Technology Centre** is regional Australia's largest not for profit educational science centre and one of only seven science centres in Australia.

Victoria Hill is the site of some of the earliest gold workings in Bendigo, dating from the 1850's. In its day it was the site of the deepest mine in Australia. Today, the large and beautiful site is maintained and open for self-guided tours.

The Bendigo Gasworks was closed in 1973 when natural gas arrived in town, the plant is maintained in working order, awaiting the day when the site is developed to allow visitors to explore coal gasification and the provision of power and light in the early industrial age.

The **Bendigo Chinese Joss House** is one of the oldest joss houses still in use in Australia. It was constructed of timber and hand-made bricks during the 1860s by the local Chinese population who settled around the Bendigo goldfields.
